

BEFORE YOU DIG, YOU MUST CALL PA-1 CALL (3 days notice) is the law

Do you have plans to dig in your yard? Do you plan to...

- Install a mailbox post?
- Plant a tree?
- Install fencing?
- Build a deck?
- Build an addition?
- Construct a garage or shed where there will be digging for a foundation?
- Install an in-ground pool?

Whenever the project requires digging you must CALL BEFORE YOU DIG.

Who to call? Call 811 - PA-ONE Call (Underground Utilities)

What is PA-ONE? PA-ONE is part of a federally-mandated national "Call Before You Dig" program.

The program was created to help protect you from unintentionally hitting underground utility lines while working on digging projects.

Avoid fines or penalties by calling this number. (811) is the central number to call for all underground utilities.

PA-ONE then notifies those who need to come mark the property.

When should you make the call? Call 811 at least three (3) business days before you plan to dig.

EVEN IF YOU ARE SURE YOU KNOW WHERE THE UNDERGROUND UTILITIES ARE - YOU MUST CALL.
